- Articles should be **4,500–6,000 words** (including the abstract, keywords and references).
- **Abstract** Submission (200-300 words) with 5-6 **Keywords**.
- **Paper size:** A4 (margin 1 inch on all four sides).
- **Full Title of the paper:** Times New Roman, 14 font size, Bold.
- **Main body of the paper:** Times New Roman, 12 font size, justified, 1.5 line space
- All authors should include their **Full Names, Affiliations, Postal Address, Mobile Number and Email Address** on the cover page of the manuscript.
- Submissions must follow the **MLA 9th Edition** style sheet.
- Manuscripts should be **original, unpublished**, and not under consideration elsewhere.
- All submissions will undergo **double-blind peer review**.
- Submissions must include an attachment of a **Turnitin** report, with no more than **10% Plagiarism**.


